

How to safely take care of mold in your home

WHAT IS MOLD?

 \triangleright Molds are fungi that are found both outdoors and indoors.

igitiarrow Molds reproduce and spread by making spores that travel through the air.



MOLD REMOVAL

Pou must fix the underlying water problem (such as a leaky pipe), or the mold will come back.

 \boxtimes If the moldy area is 10 square feet or less, you can clean it yourself, once the underlying water problem is fixed. Follow these guidelines:

Be safe! Use protective gear and open windows. Do not mix chemicals (like bleach and ammonia).

Scrub mold off hard surfaces with detergent and water.



Do not paint or caulk moldy surfaces- it will not solve the mold problem and is likely to peel off.



Get rid of carpet or porous tiles damaged by mold.

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Consult a building contractor or other remediation specialist if there has been a lot of water damage, or if mold covers more than 10 square feet.

▷ If you live in a rental, your landlord is responsible for removing the mold and fixing the source of moisture.

Tip Moisture control is the key to preventing mold.	Tip Quickly address water leaks and floods.	Tip Clean more frequently & increase ventilation.	Tip Use an air conditioner to keep humidity levels low.
